**USES** COVER CROP

### CHARACTERISTICS

Use of low TGW legumes to increase their density per m<sup>2</sup>

Specific role of canary grass in ensuring a healthy cover : very hardy grass, tolerant to virus and rust, not very sensitive to smut and not very attractive to slu

Easy to sow in mixtures

All components have a TGW <50g


**Crops benefiting from the intercrop :** Ideal before a spring crop especially spring bareley (ecluding legumes)

#### Ease of implantation : +++

Sowing date : Well suited to early and late sowings


Sowing rate & depth: 20 kg/ha - +/- 2 cm

#### Targeted density : 140 plants/m<sup>2</sup>
